# Visit to J A Collison and Sons


Saturday 14th July

Phil Collison has kindly offered South Holland Growers Club members the opportunity of a nursery visit on Saturday 14 July, starting at 2:00pm.

J.A.Collison & Sons are well-known as large producers of quality cut-flowers for major retail customers. The visit will concentrate on their Column Stock production, and offer the chance to see preliminary results of the HDC-funded Fusarium control trial using principally biological products. (Sue Lamb hopes to bring along preliminary observations from the HDC Pythium control trials at Lambs Flowers to the visit)

In addition, there is a series of trial plots showing Florensis Stock cultivars, including all current ones, plus some lines for future release under development. The wood-chip boiler will be available for viewing, and if time permits, a look at the Aster crop and longiflorum lilies at Whitegate nursery.
